## Montgomery County's Collection of Household Hazardous Waste

Montgomery County Solid Waste District in cooperation with the City of Huber Heights is sponsoring a Household Hazardous Waste collection event Saturday August 7, 2010 from 8:00 AM – 2:00 PM at Thomas A. Cloud Park, 4707 Brandt Pike. This event is free of charge and open to all residents of Montgomery County. Proof of residency in Montgomery County is required and absolutely no hazardous wastes from businesses, schools, organizations, or commercial entities will be accepted.

Items that are accepted during the Household Hazardous Waste Collection Day include: herbicides, pesticides, insecticides, mercury, flammable liquids, fire extinguishers, household propane cylinders, household cleaners, pool chemicals, and batteries and light bulbs of all types. Explosives or radioactive wastes are not accepted.
